

**Subject:** Training and creation of: (WP1d) Social Impact Check and Policy Recommendation's

**Place:** Timisoara, Romania

Training visit to Romania is planned to provide a five days training and education on creation of Policy Recommendation's. The training will take place at partner institution Banat University of Agricultural Sciences and Veterinary Medicine "King Michael I of Romania", Romania (USAMVBT) and will be for two researchers Ljiljana and Igor Pajovic under supervision of key researcher for partner institution USAMVBT Cosmin Salasan.

### **Training visit goals and activities WP 2 b**

This training is connected with activities in (WP2k) Dissemination and feedback on stakeholders opinions. The main topic of the training is creation of policy recommendations.

The training, enquires and consultations sessions as planned and displayed in the Agenda have as central purpose two main directions meant to link three components from the WP1 and WP2. The two directions are consisting of: validation for the completion of the Sociologic Impact Analysis and Assess the involvement and the specific expectations of the stakeholders to the future Mosquito Surveillance and Control System. These directions are establishing a functional solid link between the WP1d – Social Impact and Policy Recommendations, with the WP2k - Dissemination and feedback on stakeholders' opinions and WP2l – Community participation in mosquito surveillance and control. The establishment of the link is critical to test and validate the stakeholders' involvement in the creation of the future system.

Basically the aim of the training is to create policy recommendations based on a current state and analyzes of previous interventions' impact, survey stakeholders' position, designing best practices in measures' implementation as support pack for decision makers.

Based on mentioned analyzes creation of Policy recommendations and specific public communication strategy is goal of WP1d and will result delivering clear and crisp policy recommendations to decision makers.

The results of the training will contribute to the specific objective "Extension of project results to the stakeholder network and recommendations on management practices and policies". The activities aim also to draw amendments and recommendations for future strategies and measures on various policy levels based on results of previous activities in order to raise the eco-functional intensity in a sustainable and efficient vector and diseases control programme. Rising decision makers and public awareness and appreciation of treat posed by invasive mosquitoes, mosquito vectors and mosquito-borne diseases. Policy recommendations will offer the means for engagement of the community in mosquito surveillance and control, hence strongly supporting efforts for partners involved.
